The following fees, services, and opportunities are included in Boarding Student tuition: All Dining Hall Meals, Textbook Resources, Campus Safety, Blackbaud Tuition Management, Recreational Activities, Sports Participation, Music Instrument Rental, and Science/ Ceramics Lab.

San Marcos Academy uses Blackbaud Tuition Management for all invoicing and collections on student accounts. Based on the Student Enrollment Agreement, families are obligated to pay the entire tuition for that school year. A payment by the first invoice due date is required.

Parents are advised to plan for additional costs for school supplies and uniforms for their students. Please be prepared to pay at the Sabre Bookstore or Bear Outfitters for all purchases during Registration. Cash, checks, and credit cards are accepted.

### **Transportation Charges\*\***

The Academy provides transportation for school events at no cost. However, there is a charge to help defray expenses for personal travel. When students request transportation to the airport or other travel destinations, the Academy offers reasonable fees during "in-window" travel times. In-window is considered to be at long-leave or holiday time with departures and arrivals scheduled to meet busses running at approximately 12 p.m., 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. When students travel internationally, it is understood that they may need to stay overnight in the dormitory one night in order to catch an early morning flight. Should this additional night be necessary, transportation to the airport will depart the next morning at 6 a.m. Following breaks, students are "in-window" if they return within 10 hours before the dorm check-in time. Departures and arrivals outside of the normal travel time are discouraged due to staff limitations. If transportation is requested at other times, a minimum fee of \$150.00 is charged to the student to cover the cost of hiring a driver and arranging the trip. Please note the windows do not apply to arrival at the beginning of the school year.

### **Student Health Center Fees not included with SHC Basic Care**

If your student is on medication that is to be picked up by the Student Health Center, parents are subject to a trip charge and the prescription cost. All Boarding students are required to have United States- based Health Insurance. We encourage all students to have routine health checks prior to the school year. Parents who request services from local specialty doctors (dentists, optometrist, etc.) are required to set up payments with the doctor. Trip charges for special doctor visits will apply if provided by the Academy. Students are required to provide current physicals and immunizations.
